General expectations:

- Work is typed & follows genre requirements & formatting.
- MLA heading should appear on back of your project.
- Work is at least one full page & does not have excessive white space.
- Any artwork or pictures included are clear, creative, & colorful.
- Any additional research is appropriately referenced using a Works Cited page (following MLA formatting).

Assignment:

Create a wanted poster, “Old West” style, for a character in Treasure Island. Your poster should include the character’s name, description, a picture, crimes committed, known accomplices, and anything else you feel makes it look interesting & authentic. This may be hand drawn or created digitally. A developed response must accompany your Wanted Poster & should be written from the perspective of the character who created the Wanted Poster, explaining his/her reasoning & justification for creating the poster.

You will be assessed on the following:

1. Knowledge of the novel:
Your product must contain an accurate portrayal and/or analysis of the characters, themes, plots, etc. relevant to Treasure Island.
2. Quality & Effort:
Does it seem like you really tried hard to create the best product, or did you throw something together at the last minute? Is your work polished?
3. Creativity:
Did you try your hardest to create something that indicates a deep level of thought & creativity? Does your project add new insight & understanding to Treasure Island?
